When and where to register?

- You can register **1st to 20th May**
- You can do so two ways:
 - ✓ **At the school: Mondays:** 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM **Tuesday - Friday:** 10:00 AM to 1:30 PM
 - ✓ **Online** at the [Virtual Office of the Government of Andalusia](#)

Age requirement

- **16 years of age in the calendar year in which the studies begin**, if you wish to study the **same language** taken in ESO as a first foreign language.
- **14 years of age in the calendar year in which the studies begin**, if you wish to study a **different language** to the one taken in ESO as a first foreign language.

Required documents

Original and photocopy of:

Registration form	You can get it at school or download it here .
Photocopy of your passport, identity card or NIE	If you are under 18, you will also be asked for a photocopy of a parent's/guardian's ID.
Other useful documents	As we receive a large number of pre-registrations, we establish 4 priority admission groups (see corresponding documents): GROUP 1: If you have been unemployed in Spain for more than 6 months , you can submit a SAE certificate . GROUP 2: If you are currently employed , you can submit your employment contract . GROUP 3: If you are pursuing post-secondary studies at a Junta de Andalucía school, you can submit your inscription . GROUP 4: if you have been unemployed in Spain for less than 6 months you can submit a SAE certificate . GROUP 5: all the other candidates.
Academic record	ALL GROUPS 1-5: Certified copy of the degree certificate, provided it includes the grade point average (GPA), or an official transcript of records stating either the GPA or the grades obtained in each subject.

In case of a tie, a tiebreaker in groups 1 to 4 will be established as follows:

1. The highest diploma will be taken into account.
2. If the diploma is identical, the higher average will be considered.

3. If the average is the same, the lowest per capita income of the household will be taken into account.

The tiebreaker in group 5 will be based on the lowest per capita income of the household. If the tie persists, a random draw will be held.

What happens next?

The list of admitted candidates will be published on June 24th, at the school and on our website. Consult the admissions calendar [here](#).

- Candidates are responsible for following up on their pre-registration. Please consult the official calendar and the official notice board for key stages: provisional lists, regularization, appeals, and final results.
- Please note not all information is available on our website (the site will advise when admission lists are posted, but they must be consulted at the school).

What should I do if I am accepted?

- If accepted, registration usually takes place from July 1st to 10th. The dates will be advised on the school's website (www.eoijerez.com) and social media ([Facebook](#) and [Instagram](#)).
- The course **starts in September 2026** (around the 20th) and ends in June 2027.
- The class schedule is **4.5 hours per week, (2 sessions, 2 hours 15 minutes each)**. Once the registration period is over, you will be informed of the days and times of your classes.
- The **annual tuition fee is 81.41 euros**, and you will need to settle this amount at a local bank or online, but **only during the registration process, not during the pre-registration**.
- All registration documents must be submitted within the stated timeframe, either in person at the EOI, **online**, or by registered mail (our address is *EOI Jerez, Calle Ponce 10, 11403 Jerez de la Frontera - Spain*).

What happens if I am not admitted?

There will be another registration period for unoccupied places in mid-September, which will be duly announced on our website and social media.
